Round 10 Won by Ina Lee-Hall 39 Stableford points on count back from Jenny Clark and third, Linda Sumner on 37.



The Balmacewan ladies were perfect hosts and looked after us extremely well.


After a monumental battle, Otago won 10:2 (Seniors), 10.5:1.5 (Friendly). The only unbeaten player was Janet Osborn!
